Maxwell Elementary-Escuela de Inmersión en Español is a partial immersion model. Half of the school day is spent in the target language (Spanish), and half of the school day in English. Maxwell has been a Spanish immersion magnet since 1990. In 2007, the Consulate of Spain accepted the program into its network of International Spanish Academies. The school is part of
