- Gift cards of all shapes and sizes supporting unique opportunities.

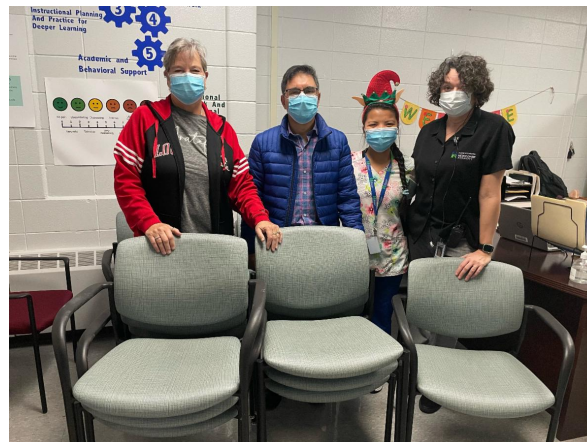
Not sure if your idea is a good fit? Send us a message. If you think it would be a good auction item, you're likely right!
